SEASONAL FLU SHOTS:

CSU Health Network has run out of the Seasonal Flu vaccine. We expect more shipments but we do not know when these will occur. There has been a temporary shortage of flu shots around the country because Flu shot manufacturers have been busy getting the H1N1 (formerly known as Swine) flu vaccine produced.

H1N1 vaccine:

The H1N1 vaccine is starting to be released in small quantities. It will be provided to those at the highest risk of complications:

- pregnant women,
- people who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age,
- healthcare and emergency medical services personnel,
- persons between the ages of 6 months and 24 years old,
- people ages of 25 through 64 years of age who are at higher risk for 2009 H1N1 because of chronic health disorders or compromised immune systems.
