70% of CSU graduates know their first-destination plans by the time they don their cap and gown.



CSU graduates are employed at a rate 10% higher than the national average, and **earn 6% more** than other college graduates.



CSU graduates are covered by graduate schools, international service organizations and other entities looking for inspired people who can change the world.



CSU graduates found jobs with more than **1,100 unique employers in 44 states**. Those interested in adding to their education were accepted at more than **200 graduate schools** and professional programs.
